This working group was formed in response to passage of SB423 (10-11-2023). This bill addresses planning and land use issues regarding production of streamlined housing, provides important recognition for historic equestrian neighborhoods throughout the state, and contains language relative to horsekeeping sites and exemption requirements. It is important to note that the bill gives local governments until July 1, 2025, to make necessary adjustments.

The working group goals are to identify and define actions (including, but not limited to drafting letters) relative to SB423 and horsekeeping protections for presentation, discussion, and possible action at LAEAC's General Meetings.
