Working under the supervision of the Senior Recreation Director, the Instructor will develop curriculum, train staff, and ensure program quality and effectiveness.

## **DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:**

- Develop detailed lesson plans and instructional materials tailored to the YEIP curriculum, focusing on career readiness, leadership, financial literacy, and professional skills.
- Ensure that curriculum aligns with YEIP objectives and youth development goals.
- Train Recreation Assistants and other support staff on class processes, instructional strategies, and program objectives.
- Mentor staff to promote consistency and high standards across all instructional sessions.
- Manage designated aspects of the program, ensuring high-quality instruction, engagement, and participant success.
- Supervise groups of up to 40 teens (ages 11-17), fostering a positive, supportive, and engaging learning atmosphere.
- Lead interactive, skills-based workshops and activities that prepare teens (ages 11-17) for future employment opportunities. Topics may include resume building, interview techniques, workplace etiquette, and problem-solving exercises.
- Lead both creative and physical activities, including indoor/outdoor games, sports, team-building exercises, and specialized workshops.
- Incorporate innovative teaching methods and interactive techniques to enhance youth participation and learning.
- Oversee the setup and breakdown of materials and equipment (e.g., canopies, tables, chairs, activity supplies) and ensure all instructional resources are available.

- Collaborate with the Senior Recreation Director on tracking program progress, evaluating participant engagement, and ensuring compliance with YEIP standards.
- Assist in enforcing program rules, emergency procedures, and risk management protocols to maintain a safe and productive environment.
- Provide additional support as needed, including preparing materials, handling paperwork, running errands, or assisting with special projects.
- Support special projects, administrative tasks, and other program needs as assigned by the Senior Recreation Director.

# QUALIFICATIONS:

- An associate's degree or higher in education, recreation, social work, youth development, or a related field (or equivalent experience) is preferred.
- At least one year of experience in teaching, training, or instructing youth programs in an educational or recreational setting.
- Prior experience supervising, training, or mentoring staff in program implementation.
- Strong ability to lead, motivate, and engage teens (ages 11-17) in structured learning activities.
- Ability to effectively communicate with youth, parents, co-workers, and supervisors, both verbally and in writing.
- Ability to think creatively and proactively solve challenges as they arise in program settings.
- Must be able to actively lead group activities, including standing, walking, squatting, kneeling, and lifting/carrying up to 20 lbs.
- Must be dependable, punctual, and responsible in carrying out assignments.
- Driver's License Preferred Applicants should be willing and able to drive city vehicles (passenger vans) and will be van-trained by city personnel.
