DESCRIPTION OF DUTIES:

- Assist in event setup and breakdown, including decorations, equipment, and seating arrangements.
- Engage and interact with teen participants to foster a fun and inclusive environment.
- Provide customer service and support to attendees, parents, and guests.
- Assist in managing event logistics, such as crowd control, registration, and activity supervision.
- Help facilitate workshops, games, and interactive activities as needed.
- Ensure event spaces remain safe, clean, and well-maintained throughout the event.
- Distribute event materials, prizes, and refreshments when applicable.
- Maintain a positive and professional demeanor, representing CLASS Parks and program effectively.
- Adhere to all safety guidelines and assist in emergency situations as directed.
- Perform other duties as assigned by the Recreation Facility Director and/or Senior Recreation Director.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Ability to work a flexible schedule, including evenings and weekends.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills to engage with teens and the community.
- Strong leadership, communication, and organizational skills.
- Must be a self-starter, able to work independently while taking direction from the Recreation Facility Director and/or Senior Recreation Director.
- be a team player, adaptable, and able to work under pressure in fast-paced environments.

- Ability to stand, walk, lift, and move equipment for extended periods of time (ability to lift 25-50 lbs. preferred).
- Applicants should be willing and able to drive city vehicles (passenger vans). Applicants will be van-trained by city personnel.
- Experience working in event planning, recreation, or customer service is a plus.
- Bilingual (Spanish) is a plus but not required.
