

Camp Granada & Sports Camp

AGES: 5 - 12 years old & 7 - 12 years old

<u>Camp Granada</u> is a day camp designed to allow your children to experience different activities in a camp atmosphere. Activities include but are not limited to, arts and crafts, sports, games, cooking projects, songs, swimming & special events. Campers will go to the pool every Mon, Wed, Fri. in the afternoon. If the pool is closed for any reason, water play on the grass may be supplemented. Children under the age of 7 will be provided alternate water/swim activities. Campers are assigned to each color group by staff. There will be no changing of groups. Campers may not switch within a week between Day Camp & Sports Camp.

All children present on field trip days (Thursday's) will be traveling with camp.

(There are no alternate activities for children who do not attend field trips.).

Fridays are "Special Event" days which consist of a dress up day and a celebration of that weeks theme. <u>Sports Camp</u> is for children who are interested in learning and playing sports each week. Our Sports Camp counselors will be coaching the fundamentals and conditioning of each sport. They will rotate through different sports throughout the day and organize intergroup games. The Sports Camp joins Camp Granada on Thursday trip days and for swimming at the pool. Sports Camp may also join Camp Granada on Fridays for "Special Event" days. Children must bring a lunch daily. Mandatory Sign in and Out of Camp by Parent or Legal Guardian

Parents please note that there will be no sign in and out privileges to minor children. All children enrolled in the Camp programs will be signed in and out by a parent, legal guardian, or individual listed on camp registration form. Granada Hills Recreation Center will not release your child to any person whom is not listed on the Registration Form as an authorized pick up person, emergency contact, or parent. We do not accept phone calls from parents who want to add someone onto the authorization list. I understand that I must walk into the office and update the list in person. Identification Required for Pick-up

ALL persons picking up any child from the Summer Camp programs will be required to show proper identification in order for the child to be released. This applies to any person picking up a child whether it be a parent, grandparent, aunt, uncle, family friend, or any other authorized person, regardless of having picked up that child previously. This is due to the fact that there may be several different staff members throughout the summer which may be in charge during sign-out periods, and the fact that it is impossible for all staff members to be familiar with all persons authorized to pick up every child enrolled in the

Refunds and Credits

Full refunds are only issued when the Recreation Center cancels the activity. A 15% cancellation fee is assessed for all refunds.
