

Field Trip Information

All Camp field trips are offered on Wednesdays unless otherwise stated. Some trips will be on a Thursday or Tuesday depending on the holiday week. Campers must be enrolled in the 5-day option in either Day Camp or Sports Camp of that week in order to attend the field trip. Times may vary.

<u>Field trip fees are non-refundable due to advance ticket purchases, even with a doctors note.</u> Field trip registration will remain open until the Wednesday (or until full) of the previous week. <u>Camp will not be in session on Wednesday for campers who did not sign up for the field trip.</u>

How to Apply:

Please fill out a Counselor in Training (CIT) application which can be found on our website. Once filled out please either drop it off to our office or email it to us at rap.northridgerc@lacity.org.

Interview:

Once we have received your applications, applicants will then be contacted via phone or email for an interview prior to any training.

Fees:

If you are selected, there is a \$40 Enrollment fee per participant PER WEEK. Once summer begins, these fees are non-refundable. Each applicant MUST be available for a LEAST 4 weeks.

Pre-Camp Training:

There will be a MANDATORY training prior to the first day of summer camp. Dates and times are TBD.

(Frequently Asked Questions)

CAMP T-SHIRTS

Campers MUST wear a Camp Kaleidoscope t-shirt every day. Each camper will receive one t-shirt for the summer. Any additional shirts may be purchased for \$15 each. Once shirts are available you will be able to pick them up in our main office in our gym or child care center.



Each camper must arrive with a packed lunch and drink on all NON field trip days. A packed lunch may be needed on certain field trips so please read weekly newsletters.

A snack will be provided daily for each camper in the afternoon extended care. If your camper has special dietary needs, please send them with their own extra snack. If your child is picked up early, they will not receive a snack.

WATER PLAY & SWIMMING

Water play and swimming will take place everyday except for field trip days.

Campers ages 5 & 6 will participate in water play activities such as slides, mini pools, sprinkler toys and an occasional trip to the pool with a supervised one-on-one visit with a counselor. Campers ages 7 & up will have the option of going to the pool. They MUST follow all Aquatic centers rules when swimming.

If your child decides not to swim, there will be a NO SWIM option that allows kids to play.

PERSONAL ITEMS

The City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks and Northridge Recreation Center are not responsible for any personal items that are brought to camp including but are not limited to water bottles, glasses, bags, games, clothing, jewelry, money, cell phones, electronics, toys, and etc. Please keep all valuable items at home!

GROUPS & FRIEND REQUESTS

Each group is supervised by both a counselor and an assistant counselor to ensure plenty of attention and support. In addition, Leaders and our Camp Director is on site providing even more sets of eyes for a safe and well monitored experience. Our Counselor-to-Camper ratio is 1:10.

We do not accept friend requests for campers in groups.

Groups are determined by age. Siblings that are the same age will be placed in the same group. Groups will combine through the day in opening circle, special events, swimming time, lunch time, and extended cares.

ACCESSIBILITY, ONE ON ONES, & AIDES

Persons with disabilities are welcomed to participate in our classes and programs. Reasonable accommodations will be made with prior arrangements. Please be aware that some accommodations may take 30 days or longer. Please submit your request for accommodations as soon as possible. Northridge Recreation Center does not provide one-on-one supervision. (There will be additional charges for one-on-ones attending field trips.)

REFUND / CANCELLATION POLICY

- Due to prior scheduling of staff, busses, trip reservations, pre-purchase of tickets, and the inability to replace your child's space on the days they are absent, NO REFUNDS, CREDITS, MAKE-UPS, OR TRANSFERS of money, including those related to illness or medical reasons will be given for any day including trip days.
- NO FULL REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED UNLESS THE PROGRAM IS CANCELLED BY THE RECREATION CENTER

PARTICIPANT'S FULL NAME: _____

1) Neither the Department of Recreation and Parks nor the Camp carries insurance.

2) A 15% administrative fee will be assessed by the City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks for any patron granted a refund. No full refunds will be issued unless the program is cancelled by the recreation center. ALL PROGRAMS SUBJECT TO CHANGE OR CANCELLATION WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE
3) Staff reserves the right to require proof of age at any time. Campers must meet age requirements by the start of camp.

4) Only the parents and authorized individuals listed on the child's application will be allowed to sign-out the child. When picking up the child ALL authorized individuals will be required to present a picture I.D. at anytime a staff member requests it. Written permission must be provided by the parent/guardian if you wish your child to be released to anyone other than those authorized on the registration form.

5)For safety purposes, camp T-shirt and tennis shoes must be worn daily. Children attending camp without a t-shirt will be issued one and you will be billed accordingly. Campers are responsible for providing and applying their own sun block as necessary.

6) Although parents are welcome to drop in and observe the camp program, for the safety and happiness of the children and staff, parents are not permitted to linger in or around the program for extended periods of time.

7) Parents are not permitted to accompany the children on any camp field trips.

8) Staff reserves the right to change or alter programming at any time without notice.

9) All cell phones, personal toys, games and other items are NOT permitted at camp. The camp, the staff and the City of Los Angeles, Department of Recreation and Parks are not responsible for any broken, lost or stolen items/articles.

10) Camp Hours are from 7:30am to 6:00pm. Camp ends at 6:00 pm. If your child is not picked up by 6:00 pm a \$1.00 per child late fee will be assessed for every 1 (one) minute late, over and above all other fees. NO ECEPTIONS
