Makeups will not be rescheduled when a class is missed by a student. No refunds and/or credits are given for classes missed by students. Makeups for classes cancelled by the instructor will be rescheduled at the end of the session.

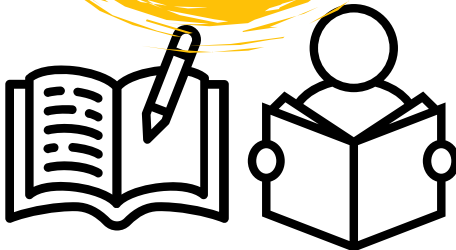
