



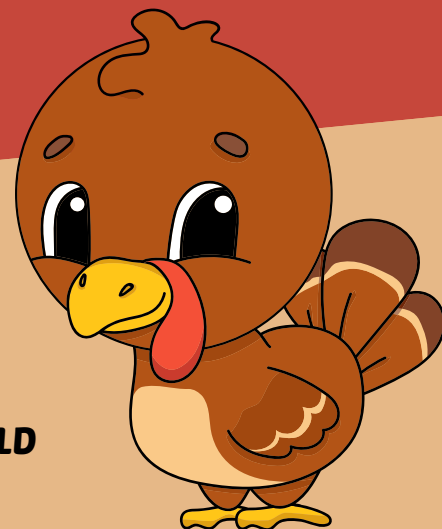

- Subject to change or cancellation.

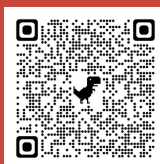

RULES AND GUIDELINES

The following rules are meant to be discussed and understood by both parents and participants.

1. Participants are expected to participate in ALL activities.
2. Safety ratios of 1 staff per 10 children.
3. Participants must follow directions at ALL times.
4. Sandals or open toe shoes should NOT be worn to program.
5. All participants must show respect for themselves, other participants and the program staff.
6. Participants must take a buddy with them and notify staff when they go to the restroom and/or to get a drink of water.
7. Participants must let a counselor know where they are going at ALL times.
8. Children must not harm anyone. No fighting, pushing, shoving, or throwing debris or objects. Children must not use profanity.
9. Participants are expected to handle Yosemite equipment, games, material and supplies appropriately.
10. Repeated reminders of inappropriate behavior, violent behaviors, bullying, discrimination or behavior that creates a safety concern will result in removal from the program.
